TITLE

- (Arial, 14 pt, bold, sentence case, centered)
- Maximum 200 characters (including spaces).
- Avoid abbreviations unless widely accepted (e.g., RNA, MRI, FDA).
- Do not use all caps.

AUTHORS

(Arial, 11 pt, bold for presenting author only; use superscript numerals for affiliations)

AFFILIATIONS

(Arial, 10–11 pt, italic)

Include full institutional names. Do not include academic titles (Prof., PhD, etc.).

ABSTRACT BODY

- (Arial, 11 pt, single spacing, justified text)
- Maximum 2,500–3,000 characters including spaces (verify current limit).
- No more than one A4 page total, including references and figure.

Recommended Structure:

- Background: Brief context and rationale.
- Methods: Experimental design, materials, analytical techniques.
- Results: Quantitative findings with key data. Avoid vague statements.
- Conclusion: Clear, data-driven conclusion and translational relevance.

FIGURES / TABLES

- Maximum 1 figure OR 1 table (if permitted in current call)
- Must fit within the one-page limit
- Resolution ≥300 dpi
- Embedded within the document (not as separate file unless required by submission portal)

- Caption in Arial 10 pt
- No color restrictions unless specified (check yearly guidelines)

KEYWORDS

3–5 keywords (separated by semicolons)

REFERENCES

- (Arial, 9–10 pt, single spaced)
- Maximum 5 references.
- Use Vancouver style (numbered in order of citation).

ETHICS & DISCLOSURES (if required)

- Statement of compliance with ethical standards (human/animal studies).
- Conflict of interest disclosure.
- Funding acknowledgment (if permitted within word/character count).

FILE FORMAT

- docx preferred
- File size typically ≤5 MB
- Standard A4 (210 × 297 mm)

No headers/footers, No page numbers, No footnotes, Use SI units, Define abbreviations at first use, Do not include acknowledgments unless specifically allowed, Do not include commercial logos or promotional content
